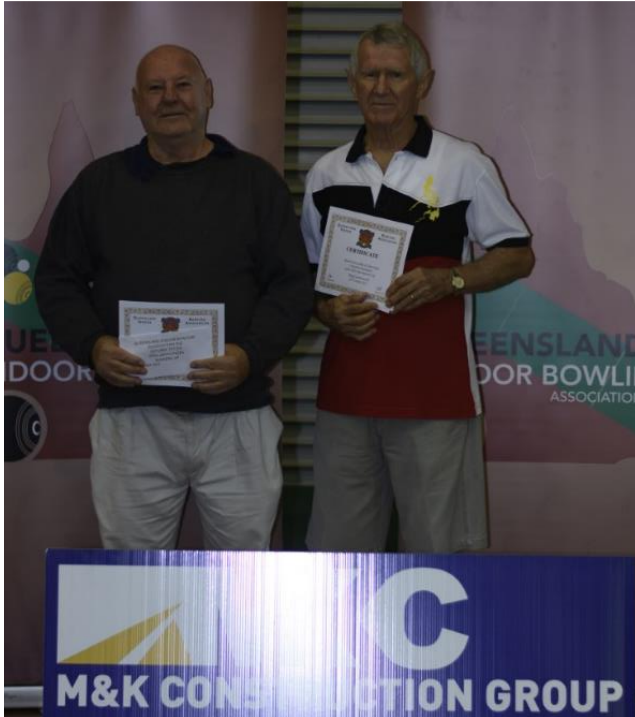

Liz joins a group of indoor bowlers who regularly play on Fridays at the Humanities Centre at the corner of Nicholas and South streets.

Kathy said Liz has bowled for at least 50 years, starting at the Baptist Church Hall at Rooval before continuing to play at the current location in the Ipswich CBD.

"She's still active; she's fantastic," Kathy said.

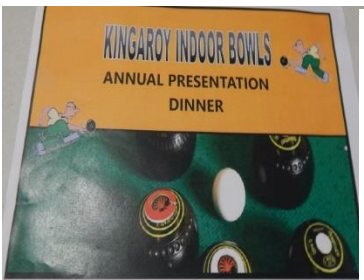
